


# **Annual Report 2024**

### What did we do this year?

#### We envisioned and equipped churches for holistic missional engagement in their local community:

- ·We journeyed with a group of 7 churches in County Fermanagh, unlocking their understanding of the bible around integral mission, their own resources and their local community.
- ·We completed successful a three-year journey with two groups of leaders from disadvantaged and marginalised communities bringing connection to like-minded leaders, new skills and understanding and renewed hope and purpose.

#### We increased and strengthened partnerships and collaboration for greater reach and impact:

- ·In partnership with Christians Against Poverty UK we have developed a Church Community Transformation manual to train up to 6 facilitators in at least 20 churches across Ireland and the wider UK.
- •The Las Casas Institute for Social Justice are partnering with us in contextualising a resource to unlock the potential of Catholic Parishes, renew faith and refresh understanding of Catholic social teaching.
- ·The Rural Community network understand the potential of the local church and are supporting the Church and Community Transformation process.

## We created resources to inspire a movement of Christians passionate about bringing transformation to Ireland:

- ·A CCT manual to support the training of facilitators across Ireland and the UK.
- ·Developed and designed two information booklets to enable people to understand the CCT process.
- ·We launched a successful 8 episode Podcast, Inspired to Act showcasing the ministries of ordinary people doing extraordinary things.
- ·We recorded a storytelling video in partnership with CAP to bring the CCT process to life.

#### We strengthened our capacity and began our task of mobilizing more resources:

- ·We took time to reflect and recast our vision and mission
- ·We moved to a more secure financial position
- ·We were able to increase our staff capacity with the appointment of a part time Development Manager.
