The Need

Now more than ever, communities need the holistic power of the Gospel. In Ireland, North and South, we face a barrage of challenges, from post-pandemic recovery, escalating poverty and inequality, the fragility of civic society and significant difficulties in accessing vital public services.

The impact is not just financial. The stress of poverty also threatens health, wellbeing and relationships. This highlights that poverty is complex and needs to be tackled holistically, building the capacity to address it at a local church and community level that does not simply pull people out of the river when they are drowning, but stops them from falling in in the first place.

The Challenges

There are certain challenges unique to Thrive Ireland that make it difficult to source funding that allows us to increase our reach and sustainability.

Our calling is not to engage in community work directly, but to inspire and train local churches to enable God's Kingdom to come in their community "as it is in heaven". This is a journey and takes time and requires mindset shift, but has greater reach and impact in the long term.

Thrive Ireland does not receive government funding and our status as a Christian charity prevents us accessing many sources of funding open to secular organisations.

Currently, almost 80% of our income comes from consultancy work undertaken by our Director, which is important in terms of the expertise delivered, but stunts our potential growth and sustainability.

We would love to reach a level of funding that would provide income to free up our Director and multiply the number of communities transformed by the local church.

The Solution

The church has a unique opportunity to help. Church Community Transformation helps churches to transform situations in a sustainable and holistic way using their God given resources, to see people living life in all its fullness.
